

The Danaw/Thanau'/Kanau' people

- Ethnologue: [dnu] population of 5000, 1000 speakers
- Three villages near Aungban in Shan State: Taungbohla, Thaethit, Chaunggya
- Language status is Threatened-Vigorous (cf. Luce, 1965), main identity marker?
- Luce, idespread multilingualism: Danaw, 14P&'109, regional Burmese, ?Shan, ?







TEK in Language Documentation

- TEK: Traditional Ecological Knowledge (also IEK, LEK, TBK, etc.)
- Useful means of documenting languages
 - Of interest to speakers
 - Plenty of material
 - Simultaneous documentation of cultural content
 - Endangered semantic domain

Domains of TEK

- Plants traditional medicine
- Large mammals
- Birds
- Honeybees
- Etc.

Why birds?

- Diverse, highly visible/audible
- Lots of associated folklore
- Birds "tell" people things:
 - warn of danger
 - news of death
 - time of day, weather, season
 - moral lessons

Challenges

- Scientific ID is very time-consuming but desirable
- Sightings are fleeting and longdistance
- Good field guides may not exist
- An 'expert' may be required

Methodology

- Stimulus: Smythies (1940) *Birds of Burma*
- Elicitation at two villages: Taungbohla (older men, ages: 50 to ~75),
 Thaethit (younger men, ages: 30 to ~50)
- Group discussion, consensus recorded

Methodology

- 'Reliable' name accompanied by accurate information about ecology, behaviour
- 'Consistent' same name offered by multiple consultants

• +R+C, +R-C vs. -R+C, -R-C





Results

- Over 70 bird names from the two villages
- Very little overlap between the two word lists (only 17 shared items, 24%)
- Referents of remaining bird names highly uncertain



Differences between the two villages

- Far more bird names from Taungbohla (48), almost double the number from Thaethit (25)
- Far more species recognised by people from Taungbohla
- Some visually striking species not known in Thaethit, e.g. jēt 'Silver Pheasant', san mī tô 'Green Bee-Eater'

- Some lexical differences
 - Unreliable ID?
 - Dialectal variatio



Conclusions

- Knowledge of bird names inversely proportional to age
- Driven by local extinction of many bird species following habitat loss in recent decades
